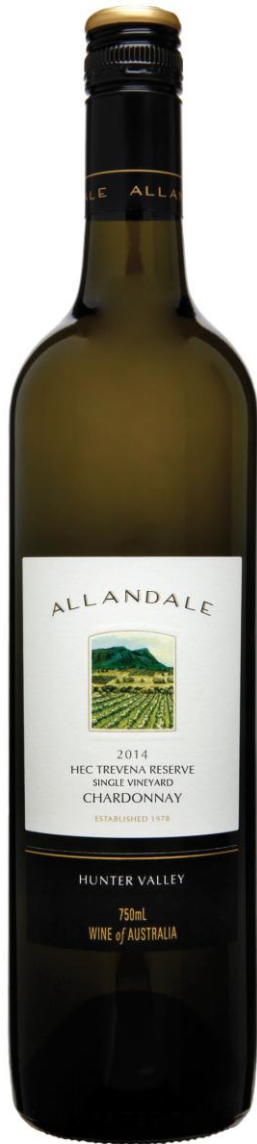

Tasting Notes



2014 WINEMAKERS RESERVE 'SINGLE VINEYARD' CHARDONNAY

VITICULTURE

Three separate picks of fruit were sourced from the highly regarded 'Trevena' vineyard in Pokolbin. Grown on ancient alluvial soil and coupled with a near perfect growing season resulted in fruit of outstanding quality. This wine is named in honour of Hec Trevena who planted and worked this vineyard up until the day he sadly passed away in February 2014.

WINEMAKING

Natural fermentation occurred in fine grain new French oak. A separate component was cold fermented in stainless steel and finished in new French oak. 'Battonage' (barrel stirring) has given complexity and body. The finest barrels were then hand selected for this small batch reserve wine.

PALATE & BOUQUET

Stonefruit, fig and toasty oak aromas on the nose complement cashew nut on the palate while extended maturation on yeast lees adds body and texture. The long finish is dry, balanced and fresh.
